**Q: Is it okay to only distribute the Eucharist (no wine) at a funeral Mass?**  
**A:** Although communion under both kinds has a fuller sign of the fullness of Christ, a decision to distribute the holy Eucharist under one specie is not forbidden, because both the consecrated bread and the consecrated wine contain in themselves the fullness of Christ and the fullness of Eucharistic grace. This is not recommended as a usual practice at mass, but it does not take anything away from the reality that the consecrated bread and consecrated wine contain separately in themselves the fullness of Christ (CCC, General Instruction of the Roman Missal--GIRM). The one to determine when it is pastorally appropriate to distribute communion under one specie at a mass is the pastor or priest who will be celebrating the mass (GIRM). Fr. Michael Chrisman, D.O.P.
