## FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

*I am the good shepherd, says the Lord;  
I know my sheep and mine know me.*

Peter stands up with the Eleven and preaches about Jesus, our "Lord and Christ." When the people hear that it is by Christ's wounds that they have been healed, they themselves are "cut to the heart." They beg, "what are we to do, brothers?" They have found in the witness of the Apostles an authority they are eager to follow. This is what Jesus means when he says that the good Shepherd walks ahead of his sheep, and that the sheep follow him "because they recognize his voice." Good Shepherd Sunday celebrates the correspondence between the longing of the human heart and "the promise made us us" that God will send a Shepherd who will give us life "more abundantly."
