## SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

## MONTH OF MAY ROSARY

The rosary will be recited every Sunday at 10:00 a.m. during the month of May.

It is time once again for the Bishop to commission the Extra-Ordinary Ministers of the Eucharist for St. Ignatius and its Mission Churches, St. Bartholomew and St. Peter/St. Rosa. Any and all parish members, (whether you have been commissioned in the past or not), who would like the privilege of distributing the Precious Body and Blood of Christ at Mass and/or take Communion to the home-bound must attend a meeting on May 30, 2017 at 7 PM here in the Church. From the attendance list, we will notify the Bishop we would like for him to approve our Ministers of the Eucharist. There is not time for a make-up class so if you are not present you will have to wait for the next commissioning class in 3 years. Once the approval is received, the actual commissioning will be done later by our Pastor. For circumstances beyond your control please notify Deacon John. You can expect a class time of 2 hours. Those wanting to proclaim the Word of the Lord(a Lector) must attend also.
