"DID JESUS HAVE A LAST NAME?" When we refer to Jesus as "Christ," we are simply affirming that Jesus is the Christ, or Messiah. Use of family (or "last") names is a relatively new phenomenon, dating back only four hundred or five hundred years. Up to that time, people lived in small or rural areas and generally went by first names only. This was the case in Jesus' time. Often, a person's town name was added to clarify who was being spoken about (e.g., Jesus of Nazareth, Joseph of Arimathea, Simon the Cyrenean). Throughout the Gospel, Jesus is referred to as "Jesus of Nazareth" (Mk 16:6), "Jesus son of David" (Mt 9:27), Jesus, the carpenter's son" (Mt 13:55) and "Jesus, the son of Joseph" (Jn 6:42). By today's standards, any of the could have been used as the equivalent of Jesus' "last name."
