- ⇒ **Parade**—It was agreed that we need additional help to ensure the safety of our spectators. We need 10 people that will stand along the route to see that children do not run in front of floats to get candy and to also keep the parade flowing smoothly. Safety Vests will be purchased with Event Staff on back. Let us know if you would like to help out.
- ⇒ **Dance**—we are exploring options for the dance. No final decision has been made.
- ⇒ **Royalty**—We welcome candidates between the ages of 13-18 to run for Fiesta Queen/King. The candidate who sells the most raffle tickets will be crowned Queen/King. The deadline is April 15th.
- ⇒ **Raffle**—We are currently accepting raffle prizes. We currently have a Handmade Quilt, Weed Cutter and \$500 Cash. We accept cash, gift cards, tools, appliances, etc. Items must be new. Deadline for prizes is April 30th in order to get State approval and tickets printed.
- ⇒ **Park Events**—COORDINATOR NEEDED! We need someone who will plan and oversee the park events. We will also need volunteers to help with kid games, bounce house, contact person to coordinate booths at park.
- ⇒ **Dinner**— will be held after Mass—still in planning stage.
